Students ...

- identify institutional and structural issues, and issues of human resource, curriculum, teaching and school development with regard to in-company and school-based training
- analyse institutional and structural issues, and issues of human resource, curriculum, teaching and school development with regard to in-company and school-based training
- develop concepts and approaches to work on these issues
- reflect and evaluate these concepts and approaches

#### Module contents

The module offers the opportunity for in-depth analysis of issues regarding staff

development, curricular, teaching and school development, and structural and institutional design in in-company and school-based vocational education and training. Four seminars have to be chosen to complete this module: two of the seminars have to focus on structural and institutional aspects, the other two seminars have to spotlight of human resource, curriculum, teaching and school development. In both subject areas, key social, economic and educational topics are addressed and discussed from the perspective of vocational education and training. These key topics include digitalization, sustainability, inclusion and integration in particular.

Winter semester: "Human resource development, curriculum, teaching and school development"

Seminar themes depend on topicality and focus of the lecturer. They might include: job-related socialisation; subjective theories of in-company trainers; vocational training for sustainable development, language-sensitive subject teaching, teacher training from a historical and international perspective, training marketing, entrepreneurship education.

Summer semester: "Institutional and structural aspects of vocational and business education"

Seminar themes depend on topicality and focus of the lecturer. They might include: vocational education and training system from an international perspective, structures and legal foundations of vocational schools, organizational structures of in-company initial and continuing vocational education and training, occupational concept and professionalism, financing, costs and benefits of in-company initial and continuing vocational education and training, inter-company and extra-company training/associated training, quality management in initial and continuing vocational education and training.

This module concentrates on the development of an empirical survey in the field of vocational education and training. The work within the module can be connected to survey drafts which have been developed in the module pb026 "Research in vocational education and training". The seminar and the tutorial support especially the following research tasks: planning methods (setting up an research plan), conception of a research design including the development of survey instruments, planning and conducting pre-tests, data analysis, presenting and reflecting research results.
